1A - TOOLS FOR CRITICAL REFLECTION AND ACTION

Using the Early Years Learning Framework and the Victorian Early Years Learning and Development Framework

1B - Programming in light of the Frameworks and Regulations

To program effectively an educator needs to provide a rich environment that is responsive to the diverse needs of children in their care. Program planning in a home based care setting presents its own challenges. This session will explore program planning for Family Day Care in the context of the EYLF and the VEYLF and the Children Service Regulations. You will have the opportunity to reflect upon planning practice in your service and examine strategies to support each child to become a successful learner.



1C - Juggling children 0-12years together successfully in FDC
